FROM THE CEO'S DESK

The past year has been one of remarkable progress and resilience for Sunbird Trust. As we reflect on our achievements, challenges and growth, I am proud to share this comprehensive overview of our journey. The year was also special for all of us as it marked the 10th anniversary of our foundation day.



Founder's note

Trustee report

During each of these past ten years we have seen our vision of building peace come to life not only through the sheer passion and commitment of our team members but also through their dedication and hard work.

This report highlights key milestones, programmatic performances and strategic initiatives that have positioned us for sustained success. With a commitment to innovation and excellence, we look forward to building on this foundation in the years ahead.

Through the generous support of all our donors, enduring partnerships with community stakeholders and hard work of our dedicated team members we have yet again scaled new heights, both in terms lives impacted through our various programmes and funds deployed during the year.

Major Highlights of the year

Government School Transformation Programme (GSTP) -

Styled on our School Transformation Programme, we entered into a long-term MOU with the Government of Arunachal district level Government School Pradesh for Transformation Programme. This strategic programme envisages to transform 11 extremely remote and near defunct government schools into Schools of Excellence serving the marginalized communities in the border district of Shi-Yomi, Arunachal Pradesh.

As many as 450 students from the most marginalized and isolated communities are provided quality education right in their own villages with our education specialists working with the local teachers 24x7. Besides this we will also be creating critical school, hostel and staff infrastructure at the schools under this programme, thereby improving the quality of physical infrastructure.









Teacher Training & Skilling Academy – We have successfully established the Axis Bank – Sunbird Trust Teacher Training and Skilling Academy. This academy aims to train teachers from the remotest parts of NE India, thereby empowering them in their professional journeys as teachers and educators. In its first year of operations, we conducted 4 batches empowering a total of 99 teachers from Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur and Assam.

Improving Government School Infrastructure – In order to complement our efforts in the private school ecosystem, we undertook a strategic programme for one of our donors to development infrastructure for 12 government schools in the aspirational districts of Udalguri, Assam and Chandel, Manipur. Through this initiative we aim to improve physical access to education for the most marginalized communities of these two districts.



Highlights in Numbers

The last year also gave us an opportunity to re-evaluate our mission numbers and with the revised target for 2030 we embarked upon with renewed zest and passion. With 12573 scholarships provided during the year we are poised to achieving our 2030 target of 1,00,000. With the completion of the underconstruction school in Kabui Khullen and hostel in Chinjoroi (both in Manipur) we have now built and dedicated a total of 21 schools and 14 hostels in NE India for the benefit of scores of students. Solar Lamp and Solar Street light installation picked up pace once again with a total of 2200 Lamps distribution across Dhemaji and Majuli districts of Assam.

Besides this we also installed 628 solar street lights in the remotest corner of Nagaland, Manipur and Assam. With these two projects alone, we were able to empower 58,818 people who hitherto were suffering from acute shortage of grid power. Other projects undertaken by the Community Development Team involved strengthening our work in the area of livelihood through the **Sloping Agriculture Land Technique (S.A.L.T.)**. With our Demo S.A.L.T. Farm in Puichi, Manipur bearing fruits (literally) we continue working with 70 farmer families across Noney district to enhance livelihood and also protect the land/soil from degradation due to Jhum cultivation.

Although the **ethnic conflict**, which erupted in May 2023 in **Manipur**, ebbed to a large extent due to the continuous efforts of all key stakeholders we continued to reach out to Internally Displaced People (IDPs) staying in various relief camps and provided them with necessary relief material ranging from blankets, Water filters, Emergency Lamps, Stationery items, Mattresses, Mosquito nets, Thermo steel Water flasks, Plastic Jumbo Clothes Storage amongst other required household items. These efforts helped provide dignified and comfortable living conditions to more than 15780 IDPs living in as many as 66 camps across Manipur's Imphal, Jiribam and Churachandpur areas.

All the magical impact was a direct result of the dedicated team of young professionals who have joined Sunbird over the years and share our vision of building peace and empowering the marginalized. We closed the year with 48 strong team mates coming from as many as 12 states of India. It is also a moment of extreme pride for us that 6 out of these are our own sponsored students who have completed their education and chosen to work with Sunbird Trust in various capacities with the passion to give back to their own communities. For us having our own sponsored students as full time Sunbirders is completing the circle of empowerment which is the core of our vision.

We are also immensely thankful to the deep support we get from our friends in the Armed Forces and Assam Rifles who enable us to reach to the farthest parts of the North Eastern India and participate along with us in nation building. From developing key infrastructure for some of our partner schools to being the logistical backbone for our men and material, our partnership with them has developed into a unique model of CSO, Army, CSR and Government working in tandem with a shared vision.

As we enter a new financial year we aim to work with renewed zeal and commitment to uphold our core values of humanity and inclusivity.

In the coming year, a key focus will be the rehabilitation and care of children affected

by the conflict—continuing our core mission of fostering peace through education.

None of the progress we have made would have been possible without the generous and unwavering support of our donors. We are truly grateful for their trust in us. We are also privileged to have the wholehearted cooperation of local state governments in all the regions we operate in. At the grassroots level, our partner organizations and their dedicated staff at the cutting edge have shown exceptional commitment, often in the face of adversity—and we are proud to stand beside them.

Our strength lies in our team. United by purpose and drawing on diverse backgrounds—social, cultural, religious, and educational—our team exemplifies the spirit of collaboration and courage. In some of the most remote areas of Arunachal, close to the China border, our colleagues continue to work with passion and dedication—often without electricity, connectivity, or even proper roads. Yet, the strength of their commitment inspires us all.

I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to our Trustees and Board of Advisors for their invaluable wisdom and guidance. Their support has opened many doors, enabling us to scale our work significantly.

Of immense joy to us is the growing success of our alumni. Throughout the year, we've witnessed our students graduate, secure employment, and begin lifting their

families and siblings with them. Their progress is a powerful validation of our work and purpose. We are especially proud to now count two of our alumni as Board Members, and seven as permanent members of our team. They bring not only lived experience but also a deep-rooted commitment to paying it forward.

We remain firm in our belief that organizations like ours in the development sector must be seen not as charities, but as equal partners in the nation-building process. Our goal is to build strong, self-reliant communities through education and empowerment.

Our newest initiatives under the Axis Bank Foundation's DilSe programme—including the transformation of six Government Schools in Shi Yomi District and the launch of the Teacher Training Academy in Mechuka—have already made a deep impact in these frontier communities. We are deeply thankful to the Indian Army, whose unwavering support through Project Sadbhavana, and with critical logistical and material assistance, has been instrumental. Similarly, in other conflict-affected regions, our strong partnership with the Assam Rifles in WHAM (Winning Hearts and Minds) continues to bear fruit—through outreach efforts in remote villages.

It has now been over a year since Aliasgar succeeded me as CEO in January 2024. With his deep and unwavering commitment to Sunbird Trust—and the return of several dedicated leaders to our team—this transition has not only been remarkably smooth but has also strengthened and built confidently on the foundation laid in our first decade.

Our tenth year has flown by and what a milestone it has been. This has been the most expansive year so far in Sunbird Trust's journey - in scale, scope, and impact. When our founder and then-CEO, Colonel Christopher Rego, decided to hand over the reins to Aliasgar Janjali in January 2024, it came as a profound moment for all of us considering his continuous and tireless efforts to raise Sunbird from the ground up into the beacon of hope, peace

and education it is today. That said, the transition has been smooththanks to Col. Chris's profound and wholehearted involvement in shaping strategy, mentoring the team, expanding the vision and critically, in fundraising. 



THIS YEAR'S ACHIEVEMENTS









This year, we amplified our community intervention efforts. The Kuki-Meitei conflict in Manipur has ravaged the state since May 2023 displacing more than 60,000 people and claiming the lives of more than 250. With the generous contribution and support of our donors, we were able to support 15,780 people across 66 relief camps. This year, we distributed solar lamps and street lights to some of the remotest of villages in the northeast, lighting the lives of 58,818 people. Through our sponsorship program, we were able to provide 12,573 scholarships, resulting in financial access to the most deserving students of the northeast; to support tuition fee, nutrition fee, college education, skill building course and more. We supported **114 partner institutions** through scholarships and capacity building of which 14 are base schools where team members stay on campus and work on strengthening school governance.









Visit to Gerizim Rehabilitation Trust

This initiative aims to connect theoretical education with professional skills. Currently, our SELF fellows are actively engaged in our base locations across Assam, Manipur, and Meghalaya.

Five out of 33 interns are currently transitioning into full-time roles, while others pursue higher education and thrive in diverse career paths. This achievement has helped us develop the SELF program towards empowering individuals and transforming communities.

Aiding Manipur's Displaced



RELIEF AND EDUCATION EFFORTS IN MANIPUR

Since the onset of conflict on May 3, 2023, which has displaced over 60,000 individuals in Manipur, Sunbird Trust has provided essential relief and educational support to more than 15,000 people across over 60 camps from March to December 2024. In partnership with generous organizations, vital supplies such as hygiene kits, kitchen utensils, solar lamps, mattresses, school materials, water purifiers, and recreational items for children have been distributed, offering crucial assistance during this crisis. In addition to material support, Sunbird Trust is dedicated to the education of displaced children. At the Akampat Relief Camp, school admission fees were covered for 183 students attending 14 different schools. In Churachandpur, 29 displaced students are enrolled at Lyzon Friendship School, while 135 are attending St. Joseph School in Singngat. Through its unwavering commitment to education and care, Sunbird Trust is helping to nurture resilience and promote peace.

Sutainable farming practices

SLOPING AGRICULTURAL LAND TECHNOLOGY (SALT)

Demo Farm, Puichi, Manipur



Sunbird Trust has implemented Sloping Agricultural Land Technology (SALT) in the Puichi cluster for 4 years, with the aim to establish an exemplary SALT Demonstration Farm. This 4-acre farm managed by Sunbird Team members Poungiale and Kholi Anthony serves as a learning space for farmers, showcasing SALT's benefits. This year 50 new farmers were introduced to SALT; a total of 69 farmers received knowledge, skills, and financial aid.

Aben

The SALT programme by Sunbird Trust started in Aben in 2024. Team members Pratip Ganguly and Rinchuiba Bariamtak engaged with Aben's SALT Development Committee (SDC) for implementation and monitoring. They conducted farm visits and 15 in-depth interviews comparing SALT with traditional jhum cultivation. Additionally, 30 new SALT farmers received training at the SALT Resource Centre with support from the Hope Foundation Academy; Sunbird team also participated in this training.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

A Programmatic Approach

On October 29, 2024, a Community Development Perspective Building workshop was held at the Sunbird Office in Majuli, focusing on enhancing understanding through interactive activities. Ten participants from various Sunbird Trust locations attended, engaging in a rich exchange of ideas. Facilitated by Mr. Pradyut Bhattacharjee, founder of SESTA NGO, the workshop included group activities such as identifying strengths, discussing meaningful aspects of their work, addressing development challenges, and visualizing concepts of happiness in community settings. Participants analyzed common themes to inform future community development efforts.

MUSHROOM CULTIVATION AT LANCHAH VILLAGE

The Mushroom cultivation project began in 2019 in Singngat, Manipur in collaboration with Sunbird Trust and ICAR. Initiated by three families from Lanchah Village, cultivation faced interruptions due to COVID-19 in 2021 and again in 2023 from a lack of proper facilities and ethnic conflict affecting spawn availability. In 2024, with support from Sunbird Trust and Mrs. Thenkhovah Haokip, a new mushroom hut was built.

ALPHA FRIENDSHIP SCHOOL TURNS 30

Since its inception in 1995, AFS has remained steadfast in its mission-welcoming students from all backgrounds and providing them with quality education and a nurturing home.

Sustaining the school has always been a challenge, as many parents (mostly subsistence farmers and daily wage labourers) struggle to pay fees. However, since partnership with Sunbird Trust in 2021, transformative changes have taken place. From rebuilding dilapidated structures to enhancing academic standards and introducing child sponsorship and nutrition programs, AFS has become a thriving learning environment. Today, 246 children from kindergarten to Grade 10 are growing in an atmosphere that instils respect for diversity, national pride, and a broader world view.

Despite challenges posed by ongoing ethnic conflict and Kachai's remoteness, construction on the new school building continued. This year, AFS proudly inaugurated the new school and staff quarters and a basketball court.

> In just a short time, Sunbird Trust has transformed the school completely. Improved infrastructure has relieved students of the hardships they previously faced. Teacher training sessions have empowered educators with modern teaching methods and innovative curriculum practices are reshaping students' perspectives on education. 


1 SCHOOL AND 1 HOSTEL BUILDING INAUGURATED







"If you don't want to teach or attend classes you should resign from your respective post," he said while cautioning of disciplinary action.

Emphasizing the need for imparting quality education and proper coordination among the teachers, SMC and other local bodies, the minister said, 'teachers should not come to me if they get terminated for neglecting their






